

# Active Directory Connector 4.0



*Manage Kronodoc users centrally in the organization's Microsoft Active Directory user database. Automatic logon of users that have logged in to the Active Directory domain controller.*

The Active Directory Connector enables use of the centralized Active Directory user database as the Kronodoc user database and therefore reduces the need for separate user administration in Kronodoc.

Users can log into an Active Directory enabled Kronodoc with their network domain passwords or optionally logon automatically if the AutoLogon server option is in use and the user has already logged in to the Active Directory domain controller.

The Active Directory Connector also allows the use of group information from the Active Directory database. In addition to Active Directory groups, local groups can be separately defined into Kronodoc.

Kronodoc stores a local copy of the user information into its database to make user information of users that have been removed from the Active Directory database available in Kronodoc for audit purposes (e.g. in logs).

## **Required software**

- Microsoft Windows Server 2003 Active Directory
- Internet Explorer 6 or 7 (for autologon)

## **PRODUCT FEATURES**

### **ACTIVE DIRECTORY CONNECTOR**

- Use user database (LDAP subtree) in Active Directory as Kronodoc user database
- Use group database (LDAP subtree) from Active Directory in Kronodoc
- Use local Kronodoc groups
- Configurable user identifier to use in Kronodoc (e.g. Full Name / Initials)
- User information cache, user information retained in Kronodoc even if removed from Active Directory

### **AUTOLOGON (optional)**

- Automatical login of Windows / Internet Explorer users to Kronodoc if user has signed in to the Active Directory domain controller
